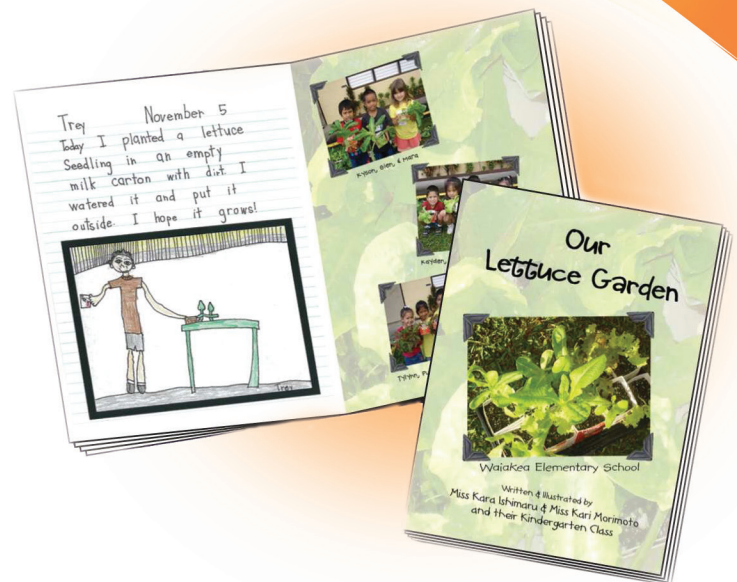
Meadow Gold Dairies is proud to present the Lani Moo Books™ Publishing Program that captures the heart and vision of Hawaii's students.
